

The NBPHE History

- ASPPH and APHA's joint initiative to established task forces on the credentialing of public health workers (1980)
- The task force reached out to other stakeholders in the credentialing process and became the Steering Committee on Public Health Workforce Credentialing (1999)
- ASPPH's Executive Committee approved developing an independent Board of Public Health to issue examinations and provide those that pass the exam with a public health credential (2002)
- The NBPHE was established (2005)
- The first CPH exam was administered (2008)




Statistics

- 5 Organizations strongly encourage who offer a discount for the CPH exam









Provisionally Certified vs. Active CPH

- Then, you will be able to use the CPH on your resume and business cards, as well as call yourself a Certified in Public Health (CPH) professional.
- We will mail your CPH certificate and lapel pin, and place you on the "Find a CPH" registry.





- Each item is examined for its performance and difficulty.
- Content—based analysis
 determines the minimum passing
 standard required to achieve
 certification.



- ➤ Handled on Pass/Fail basis
- Pass rate is more than 75%

Score Reporting


- Candidates who pass by computer-based testing will receive notification of passing status immediately

 - Comparison of performance of all candidate results compared with school candidates by core area




