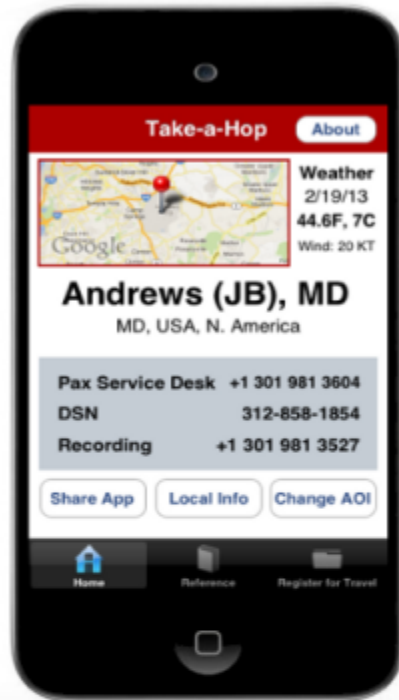

# Virtual Roll Call

## Hickam AMC Passenger Terminal Virtual Roll Call Process



1. Sign-up for Space-Available travel as you already do. This step of the process does not change.
2. Monitor the flight schedule for selected flights; they will be identified as "Virtual Roll Call." You will see this in the remarks section on the individual flight.
3. When you see a flight that is available for Virtual Roll Call, come to the Terminal and mark yourself present. You can mark yourself present up to 20 hours prior to the flight's advertised roll call time. Typically, passengers do not mark themselves present until the right before a roll call; however, there is no need to wait until then. This is required so that we can verify your documents. This is no different than the process now.
4. When you mark yourself present indicate to our Passenger Service Agents that you wish to compete virtually by giving them your e-mail address. This will only be used for official use and will be kept in a secure computer system.
5. Monitor your e-mail 60 minutes prior to roll call start time. You will receive an email asking if you to compete for a seat(s). Reply "yes" to this email with your intended destination for that flight. This verifies that you intend to compete virtually.  
\*\*\*NOTE: IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED AN E-MAIL NOTIFICATION IN YOUR INBOX, PLEASE CHECK SPAM FOLDERS FOR EMAIL.\*\*\*
6. Roll call will begin at the scheduled time, it will be no different if you are competing virtually or if you are physically in the Terminal.
7. If you are selected for the flight, you will receive a selection notification e-mail. It will have all of your check-in instructions.
8. If you are not selected for the flight, you will receive a non-selection notification e-mail. It will give you the option to physically come in to the Terminal at a specific time to see if additional seats have become available.
9. Check-in at the appropriate time listed in the e-mail and have a safe flight.
10. Please provide feedback, tell us how we are doing or how we can improve when you complete our survey in your e-mail notification or at the Terminal.

### Cost to the Government

When there are unused seats on Patriot Express missions and you fly on commercial airlines for official travel, taxpayers (you) pay twice for the unused seat!

### Baggage Allowance

Each passenger is authorized two pieces of checked baggage not to exceed 70 pounds and 62 linear inches (sum of length+width+height) each. Bags larger than 62 linear inches and/or heavier than 70 pounds will be counted as two pieces and charged as excess baggage. Piece rate prices can vary depending on your destination but will not exceed \$120. Excess baggage/pet fees can be paid by cash, check or credit card.

### Excess Baggage is Not Authorized for Space-Available Passengers.

**Carry-on Baggage** must fit under the seat in front of you or stowed in an overhead bin. Approximate dimensions are 9" x 14" x 22" for a total of 45 linear inches.

**Baggage Exceeding 80 Linear Inches and/or 100 pounds WILL NOT be Accepted.** Disposition of unauthorized weight or oversized baggage is responsibility of the owner/traveler and you will have the option to acquire boxes or purchase luggage to meet authorized weight/dimensions.

**Controllable Carrier Delays.** Delays within control of the carrier, e.g., maintenance or late arrivals. If delay extends over a meal period, all manifested passengers will receive hot meals, billeting and transportation to/from meal and billeting areas. **NOTE:** This only applies to Space Available passengers that are thru-load to their final destination. This does NOT apply to originating Space-A passengers unless aircraft has blocked out (pulled away from gate). If DUTY passengers, NOT Space-Available passengers, miss their commercial connecting flight caused by an AMC mission delay, and arrival at manifested destination is two or more hours after scheduled arrival time or passenger receives their baggage late, contracted airline will reimburse you for fees imposed by your commercial airline. An AMC boarding pass and documentation from the airline charging you this fee will be required to claim any reimbursement.

**Non-Controllable Carrier Delays.** Delays not within control of the carrier, e.g., inclement weather or Air Traffic Control delay, the Government assumes responsibility for all manifested passengers. If this type of delay requires an overnight stay, lodging, to include transportation to/from, is provided. Meals are responsibility of the traveler and are reimbursable through official travel per diem.

## HELPFUL HINTS

**Prior to Check-In and Flight Departure.** Please remember, you, the owner are responsible for obtaining all required documentation, e.g., microchip, immunizations, border clearance, kennel labels requirements, DD Form 2208 Rabies Vaccination Certificate or civilian equivalent, DD Form 2209 Veterinary Health Certificate or civilian equivalent, bi-lingual certificates and proof of ownership.

**Pet and Kennel.** Allow your pet to get accustomed to the kennel a few days before departure so he/she will be more comfortable in his/her temporary home during flight. Animals travel under less stress when they become accustomed to their shipping container before they travel. Use their kennel as a bed or feed your pet in the kennel for several days before your trip. A familiar article of clothing or toy in the kennel may help placate your pet.

**Leash.** You should exercise your pet before arriving at the terminal. Carry a leash with you so you can walk your pet before you check-in and after arrival at your destination.

**Tranquilizers.** The American Veterinary Medical Association does not advise sedation since effects of tranquilizers on animals at high altitudes are unpredictable. If you plan to sedate your pet, you must have written consent from the pet's veterinarian.

**Kennel and Pet Identification (ID).** Mark kennel with your pet's name, your name, destination or unit address, and phone number if available. We also suggest you purchase an ID tag for your pet.

**Pet Health.** Have your pet evaluated by your personal veterinarian to be sure he/she is fit for air travel. Ensure your kennel has adequate ventilation and your pet is free of respiratory problems. Some species (e.g. pug or snub nosed dogs and cats) have difficulty breathing even under normal conditions. Female pets that are in heat (estrus) will not be shipped due to possible distress to other pets and/or may result in injury. We cannot accept females with suckling young or un-weaned animals. Weaned puppies younger than 8 weeks old will not be accepted for air shipment due to the possibility of dehydration. You should also feed your pet a very light meal and provide water before turning him/her in for shipment/travel.

**Pet Stress.** Keep strangers, especially children, at a safe distance if your pet seems to be nervous. Even the most gentle pet can be provoked into growling or snapping.

**Additional Information:** Check-in time for AMC flights at Baltimore/Washington International Airport is NO LATER THAN 2 hours and 20 minutes prior to flight departure. Check-in time for AMC flights at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport is NO LATER THAN 3 hours and 20 minutes prior to flight departure.

Contact your local transportation office or AMC passenger terminal for more info. Passengers on Patriot Express missions may check-in up to 6 hours prior to departure; but, due to limited pet storage space, you must retain custody of your pet until 45 minutes prior to boarding unless there is a suitable holding area available. All pets must remain in their kennel or shipping container while in public or terminal areas.

**\*\*\*Be prepared to defray additional associated costs\*\*\***

Fees are charged on a per kennel basis depending on the combined weight of your pet AND kennel and can vary from \$125-\$375. Your pet(s) and kennel with combined weight  $\leq$  70 lbs will be charged as one piece of excess baggage. Pet(s) and kennel with combined weight of 71-140 lbs will be charged as two pieces of excess baggage, pet(s) and kennel weighing 141-150 lbs will be charged as three pieces of excess baggage. Pet(s) and kennel weighing > 150 lbs will not be accepted for shipment under any circumstances.

If ground time exceeds 2 hours, pets will be off-loaded and owners will be provided an opportunity to visit their pets. When passengers are allowed to disembark from an aircraft due to flight delay, pet owners will also be provided an opportunity to visit their pets in order to walk them and provide water.

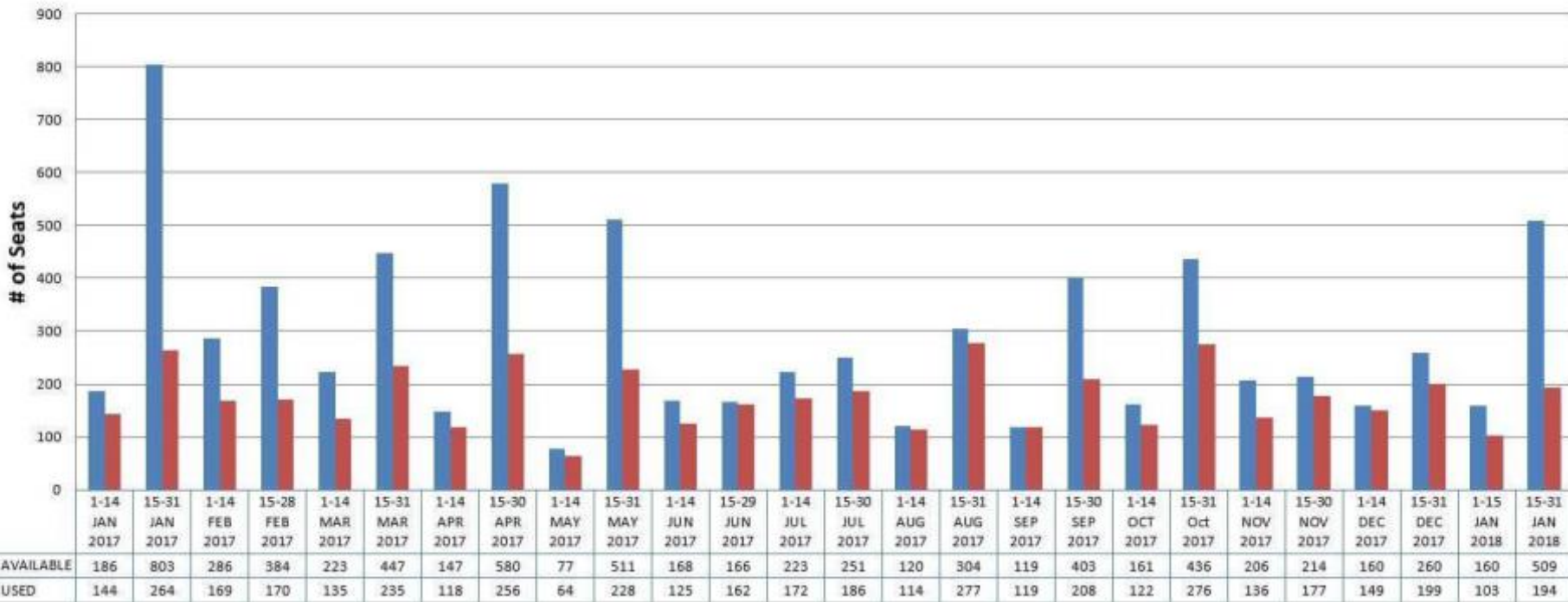

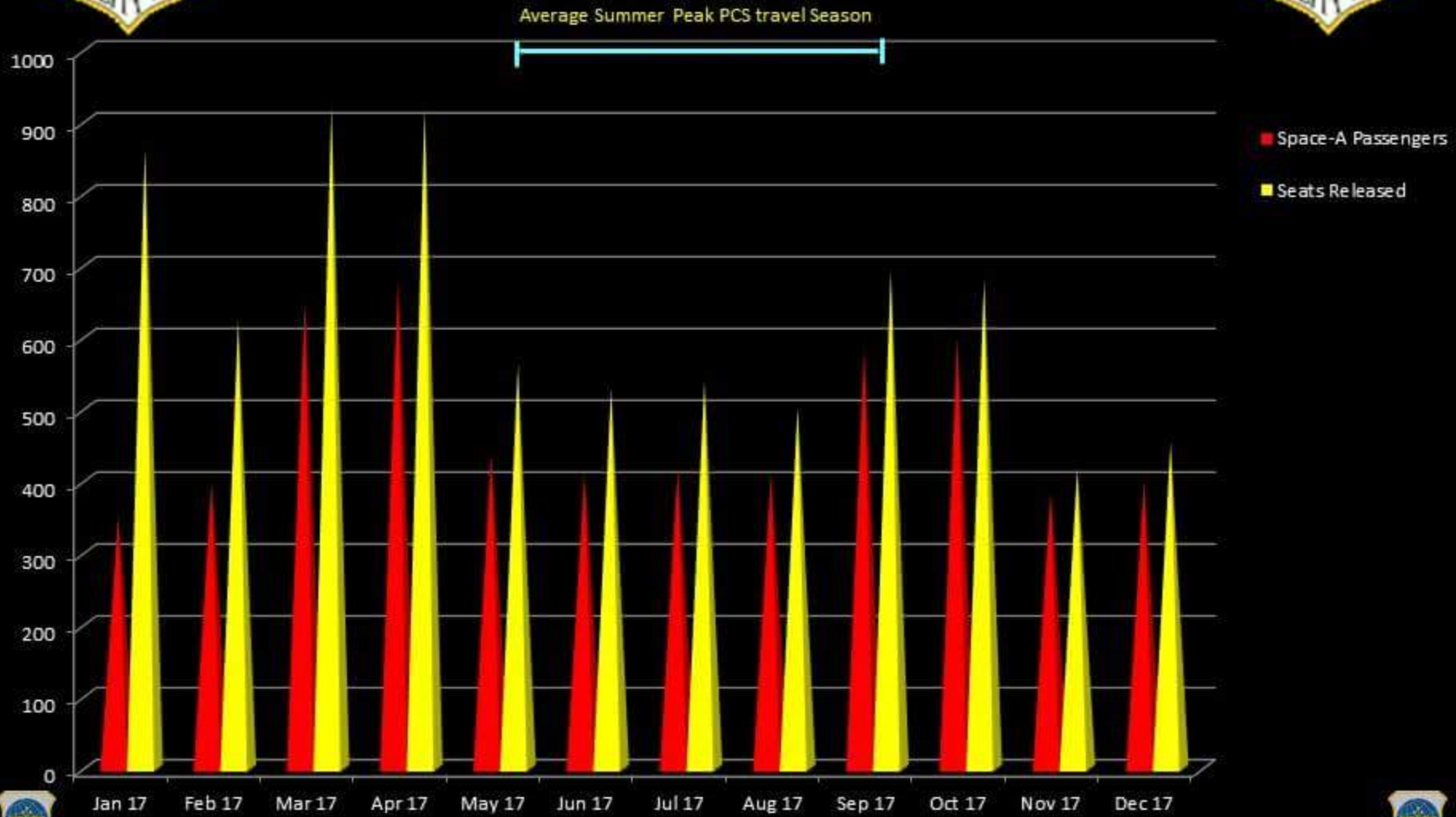

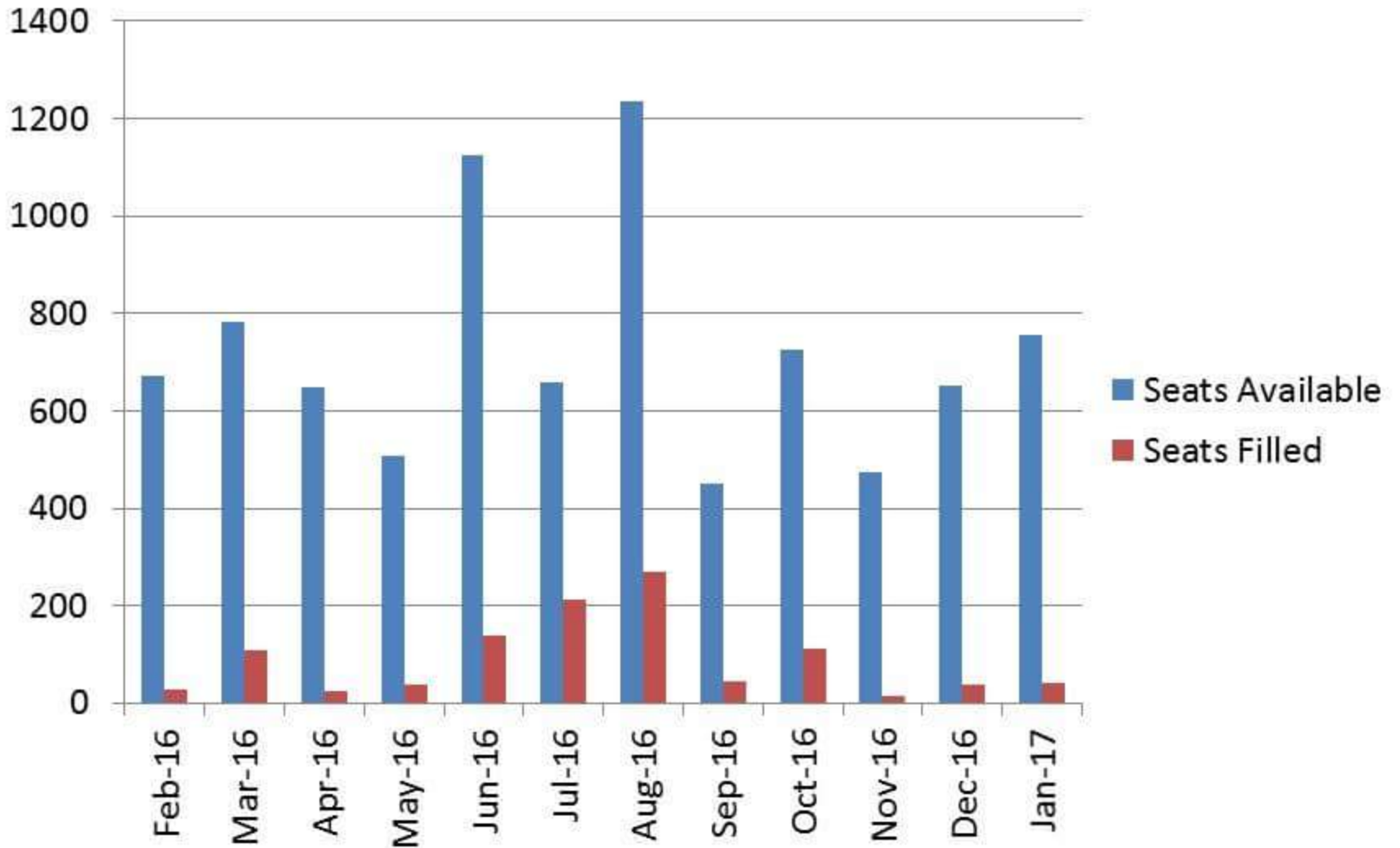

# Space A Pearls

- Attend an informational briefing offered at respective air terminals
- Use AMC GRAM – Each terminal has one which contains terminal and local info; VERY useful
- Note flight patterns and schedules

# Tips for the Space-A Traveler

- Packing---keep it simple
  - Allotted two (2) pieces of luggage up to \*70lbs; -think about walk to billeting, different modes of transportation, etc.
  - Purchase universal converter (most base lodging have 110 volt, but just in case)
  - Check weather of your destination(s) and pack appropriate clothing (hiking, skiing, visiting a roman bath, etc.)

\* Some Space-A only allow one (1) piece of luggage no more than 30lbs—check with AMC

# Before You Hop


- **Research the country(ies) you plan to visit**
  - ✓ Do an online check of the base you will be flying into
  - ✓ Act as if you were PCSing there, look for the “newcomers” information---plenty of tips/customs and courtesies
- **Check with your phone carrier about adding international plan OR get a pay as you go when at your destination (available on base)**
  - ✓ might need it to check on Space-A departure, etc.

- Download travel apps----some do not require WiFi to work!
  - Currency exchange
  - Local metro map app (i.e. Paris, London)
  - Tripomatic (purchase the package that can be used w/o internet connection)
- Check out the Information Tickets and Tours (ITT), MWR, or USO online for your destination
  - Lots of day trips---great prices
  - Germany: [www.RTTtravel.com](http://www.RTTtravel.com)



- Make billeting reservations in advance to all of the destinations you plan on visiting:
  - ✓ <http://www.dodlodging.net/>
  - ✓ Ask about CX policy----if you know you will not be making Space-A, you can CX/adjust reservation accordingly to avoid a no show fee
- Rent a car and see the local sites
  - ✓ Make rental reservation online
    - ✓ *MUCH cheaper* than at rental counter
    - Rental companies in Germany: SIXT
      - ✓ Keep in mind, gas is more expensive outside of U.S.

- If going to Europe; convert dollars/buy currency ahead of time through your bank----save on commission fees
  - ATMs on base will dispense both local and U.S. currency (bank may charge a conversion fee)
- Think about getting an international CC
  - No foreign transaction fees when “shopping”
  - Ex. PenFed Credit Union
- Always carry some cash, some places do not accept CC (i.e. taxis and smaller dining establishments)

- Have your passport and CAC on you at all times AND **protect your belongings!!!**
    - Unfortunately, Paris has the worlds best pickpockets
  - Use a fanny pack or carry your back pack securely
    - Carry water and light snacks
  - Purchase souvenirs on base
    - Typically have off base vendors/merchandise but cheaper than on the economy

# Always have a Back up Plan

- Military Airfare: Some airlines offer a full refund on military airfare. On high demand routes, may want to purchase one way ticket for the return (as insurance) and if not used, get a refund; only cost is your time and effort
- Southwest offers no cost exchanges and full refund military airfare. American, Alaska, Delta, United Airlines also offer military airfare with varying rules but must call for all of these.

# Have FUN!!!

- TSA procedures enforced for AMC flights
- Research the country/base you will be visiting
- Be flexible and have a contingency plan
- Customs and courtesies---represent yourself and USPHS CC positively
- Space-A is a privilege NOT a right
